- I. Concept Paper Phase Questions:
- Q1. HAVE A COUPLE QUESTIONS.
 - 1) IT SAYS ON THE BOTTOM OF THE PAPER'S TEMPLATE THAT THERE SHALL BE A SEPARATE PAPER FOR EACH TECHNOLOGY, DOES THIS APPLY FOR VARIOUS RESEARCH AREAS FOR DIFFERENT COMPONENTS OF A PROCESS AS WELL? FOR INSTANCE, IF I HAVE A NOVEL REFINING PLANT AND I'D LIKE TO PROPOSE RESEARCH ON VARIOUS PARTS OF THAT REFINING PLANT, SHOULD I SUBMIT ONE CONCEPT PAPER OR MULTIPLE CONCEPT PAPERS FOR THE VARIOUS RESEARCH COMPONENTS?
 - 2) HOW CAN I GET AN ASSIGNED CONTROL NUMBER?

ANSWER: 1) ARPA-E will not pre-assess applicants' proposals.

- 2) The ARPA-E Funding Opportunity Exchange website assigns Control Numbers to submission records when:
 - The applicant clicks the "Apply" button;
 - Completes the Concept Paper Details form; and
 - Clicks the "Create Concept Paper" button.
- II. Full Application Phase Questions:

Q2. WE RECEIVED NOTIFICATION THAT ENCOURAGED US TO SUBMIT A FULL APPLICATION.

OUR CONCEPT PAPER HAD A VERY LIMITED SCOPE BUT WE HAVE CONTINUED TO BUILD OUR

PROJECT TEAM AND WOULD LIKE TO PROPOSE AN EXPANDED SCOPE/BUDGET TO ACHIEVE

MORE INDUSTRIAL RELEVANT DATA. IS AN EXPANDED SCOPE PERMITTED IN THE FULL

SUBMISSION? IF SO, IS THERE A BUDGET CAP OR MAX BUDGET RECOMMENDATION ON A

PROPOSAL?

ANSWER: Yes. As stated in the FOA, awards may vary between \$500,000 and \$5 million.



Q3. WE ARE STRUGGLING TO GET THE WORK INTO THE BUDGET WITH REGARDS TO PHASE II AND PHASE IIS.

IS THERE ANY FLEXIBILITY TO MOVE \$500,000 FROM PHASE IIS INTO PHASE II?

ANSWER: Not at the pre-award stage.

Q4. QUESTION 8 OF THE BUSINESS ASSURANCES & DISCLOSURES FORM REQUIRES A DUN AND BRADSTREET DATA UNIVERSAL NUMBERING SYSTEM (DUNS) NUMBER?

DUN & BRADSTREET IS NO LONGER ACCEPTING NEW D-U-N-S NUMBER REQUESTS FOR THE PURPOSES OF REGISTERING A BUSINESS WITH SAM.GOV. PLEASE VISIT HTTPS://SAM.GOV/CONTENT/HOME TO REGISTER FOR A UEI (UNIQUE ENTITY IDENTIFIER) WE DO HAVE AN ACTIVE SAM REGISTRATION.

CAN I IGNORE THE DUNS NUMBER REQUEST?

ANSWER: Yes, but you must have a UEI number prior to award.
